## Norfolk Lions Community Day 7th Annual Youth Art Show - 6/4/16

## Guidelines: Show is open to all Norfolk residents grades 1 through 6

- 1. Artwork to represent a scene around Norfolk. It must be drawn or painted on paper no larger than 11"  $\times$  17" or 3D no larger than 17"  $\times$  17"  $\times$  12".
- 2. One entry per person and the contest is *FREE* to all participants. Each entry must include an entry form taped to the backside of the artwork.
- 3. The grand prize and winning entries from each category will be displayed at the library for two weeks after Community Day. All other entries can be picked up in person at Community Day after 2pm. After that an email will go out with specifics for picking up art work.
- 4. Entries will be judged by a panel appointed by the Norfolk Lions. Specific criteria will include artistic creativity, neatness, and originality. There will be three age categories grades 1 and 2, grades 3 and 4, and grades 5 and 6.
- 5. All entries will be part of the show and will receive an award. For each age category, the Lions will award ribbons as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> place, 2<sup>nd</sup> place, 3<sup>rd</sup> place, and honorable mentions. In addition to the ribbons, the three 1<sup>st</sup> place winners will receive a gift certificate for \$15. We will also have one Grand Prize winner, who will receive an award ribbon and a \$25 gift certificate.
- 6. Contest deadline is Friday, May 20th, 5 pm.
