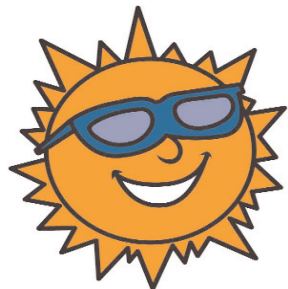

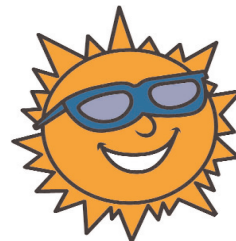

Course Options

We maintain a 10:1 ratio and the kids are **grouped by their age/grade level** into each course activity.

Staff Costume Day

Chess-Beginner & Experienced - Learn how logic, strategy and creative problem solving skills are applied from the opening move to checkmate. Continue to develop your knowledge through set plays and strategies. **O/S**

Claymation - Combine sculpture and movie making as you bring your clay masterpieces to life while creating an animated film. **S**
